 - 1. Inflation rate: 3% per year
 - 2. Expenses included: Service charges, remodelling, maintenance of air-conditioners, furniture, washing machines(for dorm), maintenance of boilers, utility fees, and maintenance of elevators, etc.
 - 3. Expenses not included: dormitory (waterproofing and painting of buildings' roof and walls, replacement of roof finishing materials). underground public facilities (electricity), married student's apartment amenities (playground, garden, parking lot, and water purifiers, etc.), and Hara Hall maintenance, etc. (In principle, these need to be included in the Minimum Expenses).
- X Increased rates are applied as of March 1, 2023, and every March 1 until 2027.
- * The increase rate will be reviewed every year in accordance with the inflation rate from

2028 onwards.

 - 1. Married Student Apartments
 - Apt. E and F (Before Renovation) 150,000won/Month
 - Apt. E, F (After Renovation) and G: 230,000won/Month
 - 2. Undergraduate Dormitory
 - 9th or 10th semester: Double Rates

For double major students, regular rates will be applied up to 10th semester. However, if he or she withdraws double majors before graduation, double rates will be charged retroactively.

- 11^{th} or 12^{th} semester: Triple Rates

For double major students, double rates will be applied. However, if he or she withdraws double majors before graduation, triplle rates will be charged retroactively.
