Announcement of Declaration and Withdrawal of Minors for the Spring 2025 Semester

1. Requirements for Completing Minors

- a. A minor will be recognized if the student meets the specific credit requirements for the selected minor, including completing at least 15 credits in the minor field, in addition to their major.
- b. Students must study for at least 1 regular semester after selecting a minor.
- c. Fields: Electrical Eng. and Computer Sci., Materials Sci. and Eng., Mechanical and Robotics Eng., Environment and Energy Eng., Life Sciences, Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Biomedical, Culture Technology, Intelligent Robotics, Humanities and Social Sciences, AI Convergence, <u>Energy</u>
 - ** Humanities and Social Sciences Minor: Select one from the five fields (Literature & History, Public Policy, Economics & Business, Science, Technology and Society, Mind & Behavior).
 - * Minor in Semiconductor Eng. is not offered.
 - * Energy Minor: Only minor cancellation is allowed. Minor declaration is not offered from the 2025-1 semester
 - ** Dept. of AI Convergence, Dept. of Mathematical Sciences, and Dept. of Biomedical Science and Engineering: (2025-1 semester) Select from the existing related field minors.

a. Completion of at least two regular semesters with a GPA of 2.5 or higher.

4. FAQ and Other Inquiries

 $\sqrt{}$ Can I declare or cancel a minor in my graduation semester?

- => Yes, you can both declare and cancel a minor in your graduation semester. However, you can only declare a minor if you are able to meet the requirements for that minor, including the courses you will take in the Spring 2025 semester. If you have already declared a major but expect not to meet the minor requirements by the end of the Spring 2025 semester, you must apply for minor cancellation.
 - * If unforeseen circumstances arise, such as not meeting the minor requirements due to the Fall 2024 grade processing results, a separate exception cancellation period will be announced in November. During this period, only students expected to graduate may apply for cancellation.

\checkmark Can I declare more than one minor?

- => Yes, you can declare more than one minor during your studies. However, within the "Humanities and Social Sciences" category, only one minor can be chosen.
 - e.g., Physics Minor/AI Convergence (O), Mathematics/Literature and History (O), Literature and History/Public Policy (X)
